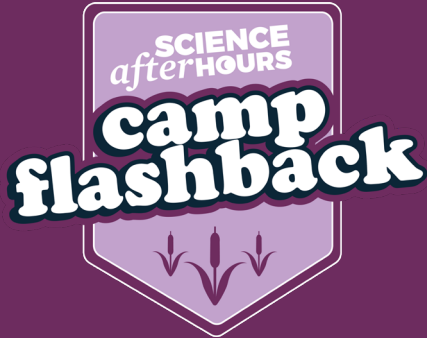

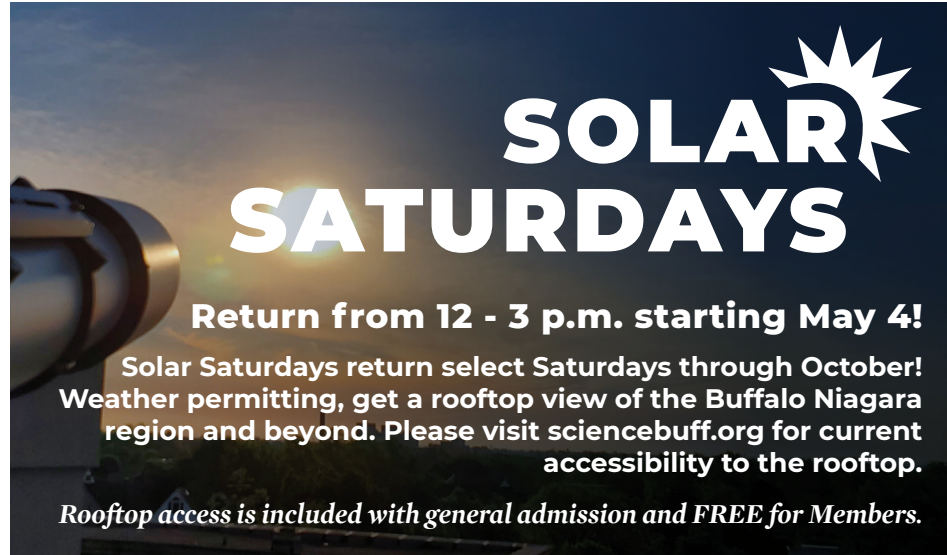

## TIFFT'S ACCESSIBLE TRAIL

Tiftt is beginning the construction phase for an accessible trail, a .75-mile loop that begins at the Darling Education Center and leads visitors of all mobilities around Heritage Boardwalk to enjoy the beautiful cattail marsh.

Anticipated to open in late 2025, the trail will feature a number of highlights, including:

- concrete walkways to doors of the Education Center
- compacted trail surface
- wider, rebuilt Heritage Boardwalk
- viewing platform accessible by wheeled mobility devices

The Buffalo Society of Natural Sciences received financial support for the accessible trail from Erie County, New York State, Buffalo & Erie County Greenway Fund, The Ralph C. Wilson, Jr. Legacy Funds at the Community Foundation for Greater Buffalo, and the Montgomery Family Foundation.

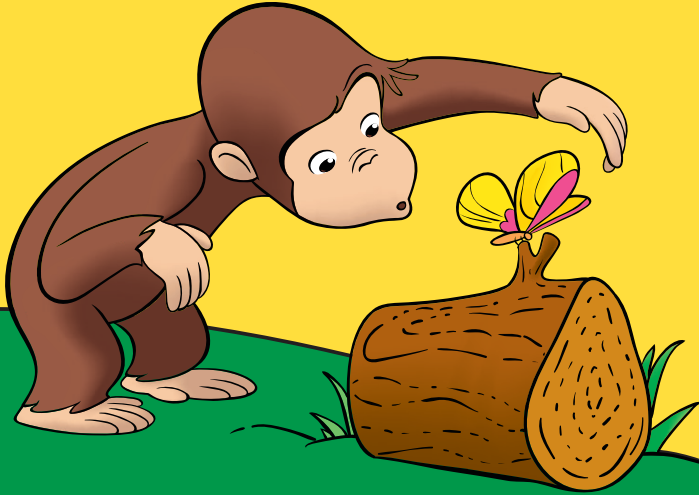
